Arts Council Presents Second Art Exhibition
Local Artists Featured

Highland, IL (June 2011) –The artists keep on coming! The Highland Arts Council is pleased to present the second in a series of Art Exhibitions on display in downtown Highland, one block from the Square. Pop Pop’s Custard and Coffee Shop, located next to Super Valu, now shows the artwork of Jerome Zobrist of Highland during the months of June and July.

Jerome is a long-time resident of Highland and an avid sportsman as well as an artist. He uses his experience in nature to study all sorts of wildlife and captures their essence in a mixture of mediums. According to Brady Kesner, President of the Highland Arts Council, “We are excited to feature Jerome as the second artist in this on-going display of artwork near the Square. With its central location within walking distance of the Square, Pop Pop’s is the perfect atmosphere to exhibit art. We can imagine a family enjoying the colors of the fountain followed by a walk to see the work of local artists over a bowl of custard or a cup of coffee!
